


Apropos to the above cited subject and reference, it is submitted that the inputs regarding J&K Draft Poultry Policy 2016 are as under:-

S No.	Recommendations	Action
1	To tie up with the Agricultural Universities for providing consultancy and expertise in the establishment of units	The Department of Animal Husbandry has got enormous talent and expertise and is already providing consultancy services and technical expertise to the farmers in establishment of their units. However, in some extraordinary cases expert opinion can be sought from SKUAST wherein advanced technical guidance is required in terms of disease diagnostics etc.
2	To tie up with the industry and commerce department for earmarking of land in the industrial estates for Animal /Sheep Husbandry Department /Potential investors in the line.	The matter regarding earmarking of land in the industrial estates is to be taken up by the Administrative Department with revenue authorities or other concerned departments. Once land is identified for the purpose, the department shall follow the case and will prepare project reports for establishment of units.
3	The modus operandi for establishment of infrastructures under PPP mode and methodology to be elaborated.	Public private participation shall be encouraged for :- i) Development and running of hatcheries in the State. ii) Finance Department order No. 238-F of 2015 dated: 08.12.2015 shall be taken as general guideline in the matter. However the detailed modus operandi shall be formulated after the Poultry Policy is approved by the Administrative Department.
4	The department may identify Nodal Officer with name of the officer, designation, mobile no., etc for registration of poultry units with checklist of items for registration of units and should act as a facilitator in setting up of poultry units;	Joint Director Poultry has already been nominated as the Nodal Officer for all issues related to Poultry. He will prepare the checklist of items for registration of poultry units in consultation with this Directorate and shall act as a facilitator in setting up of poultry units.
5	The registration of units should be valid for at least a period of 10 years instead of 2 years	Yes, we agree. The validity period of registered units can be decided, once all the norms for registration are framed by the Nodal Officer and finally approved by the Administrative Department
6	Poultry feed making/ Hatcheries with meat processing/ activities be covered under state Industry Policy 2016 and issue be taken up with Industry and Commerce Department for incorporation under the definition of Industrial activity as per the National Industrial Classification for India.	All Poultry Feed Manufacturers/Hatcheries with meat processing activities are already registered with State Industrial and Commerce Department
7	The department may formulate operational guideline of bankable schemes for establishment of Poultry Units in consultation with the stakeholders	Once the Poultry Policy document is approved, the department shall prepare the bankable schemes in consultation with the farmers and the stakeholders.
